

# Supervisor's Report Virgil Township

## Year End 2011-2012

The year 2011/2012 has found the board going through the process of selecting an Architect for the building project. Architectural Resources from Geneva procured the bid. The completion of the architectural work is to be finished when the building is build. The site map and Soil and Water Conservation District Land Use Opinion was prepared by E\*D\*S Environmental Design Service and Red Pencil/Western Engineering. The Purposed use intent was sent to the Kane County Storm Water Management Department.

A bid specification packet was prepared and let for the project in August. Our specifications were unclear and bidders had to many variances. In all fairness to the bidders, all bids were declined. The board then reviewed the bid process and in February hired Ted McCannon from E\*D\*S Environmental Design Service to facilitate the building project. An Ordinance to build the facility was prepared for adoption. The bid packet is being prepared at this time. While the board was busy working on the building process, the regular business of the Township Government was hard at work.

The Highway Department completed Phase II of the Winters Road Project at the cost of \$133,000 dollars. Phase III the last mile of this road is scheduled for 2012-2013. A light snow year makes this project possible. A good spring has left our gravel roads in good order with work needing to be done on County Line Road and Ramm Road. Continuing work to patch and repair existing roads was done.

General Assistance received a few inquiries and applications. None were qualified to receive funding.

The 708 INC Board held their regular meetings and encourage the citizens to take advantage of the social services funded through the consortium.

The Solid Waste Disposal put on its' white goods pick-up days and works with the waste hauler contracted for the Township. They put out a newsletter and always support that we; Re-use, Reduce, and Recycle.

The Drainage Districts also met at the Township Office. All are busy cleaning out the drainage ditch water ways.
